

Multi Line Prediction And Alignment Options With Equatio

The new **Equatio** update allows for multi line prediction using our **Equation Editor**. Below you can find a short video outlining this new feature as well as how to quickly navigate, along with a handy table containing the shortcuts that have been added in order to streamline the experience of Equatio in G Suite!

Keyboard Shortcuts	Result
Enter	New line in Equation Editor
Ctrl-Shift-Enter	Copy current line and paste into a new line in Equation Editor
Shift-Space	Create a new column and align vertically
/	Create a fraction with the previous term in the numerator
<code>\text</code> TAB or <code>\text</code> + Press Enter	Toggle to text mode
Highlight selection then type <code>\sqrt</code> + Press Enter	Put selection inside of a square root
Highlight selection the type <code>\underline</code> + Press Enter	Underlines the highlighted selection
Highlight selection then type <code>\overline</code> + Press Enter	Overlines the highlighted selection
CTRL + ALT + Y	Click on the inserted math and access the ALT Text for inserted math
