


Installing The Arabic Microsoft Naayf Voice


1. Select the Windows start button and select Settings.



2. Choose Time and Language




3. Select Region and Language

You can type in any language you add to the list. Windows, apps and websites will appear in the first language in the list that they support




5. Choose the **Arabic (Saudi Arabia)** language and install. When installation has finished you will return to the **Region and Language** page.


