In order to use Read&Write for Windows in the Chrome browser, you'll need to install the **Support for Read&Write Desktop** extension. This Chrome extension lets you use your Read&Write for Windows toolbar to read text, look up words, collect highlights to Word, and more.

To install, just open Read&Write for Windows and then open the Chrome browser. A new tab will open prompting you to install the extension:-
