What is the difference between them?

Clearspeak is a more natural speech or normal way of speaking math terminology.

Mathspeak is a more precise manner of speaking to help provide greater possibility of understanding the math for visually impaired users or blind users.

Using the example below

a + b

In Clearspeak, this would be read as "the fraction with numerator a plus b and denominator c"

In Mathspeak, this would be read as "Start Fraction a plus b over c end Fraction"

By default the Speech engine is set to automatic. While we recommend using the Automatic setting, if users have a preference they would choose it under Options.
