
How Can I Add A Language Voice To Read&Write For The Mac

Different voice languages for Mac can be installed through macOS's System Settings.

To download extra voices:

1. In System Settings, click Accessibility, then Spoken Content. Click on the information icon next to the selected system voice.



2. Select the language of the voice you would like to add on the left, then click on the current voice name.
