


# ClaroRead Cloud Set-Up

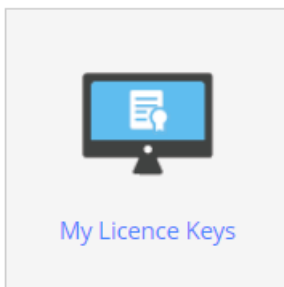
