

Data Dashboard: Understanding Your Product Data

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This article provides definitions of the most common features seen in the Feature Usage graph for all products in the Data Dashboard.

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Read&Write

Feature name	What it means
Text to speech	The number of times a user clicks Play, Pause, Stop or Hover Speech
Prediction	The number of times a user turns on Prediction or inserts words from the Prediction list
Speech to text	The number of times a user turns on Talk&Type
Highlighters	The number of times a user clicks a highlight color, clears their highlights, collects highlights, or builds a vocabulary list
Check It	The number of times a user turns on Check It or uses the features within it to correct spelling and grammar errors
Picture Dictionary	The number of times a user turns on the Picture Dictionary or looks up words
Dictionary	The number of times a user turns on the Dictionary or looks up words
Translator	The number of times a user turns on the Translator or looks up words
Screenshot Reader	The number of times a user uses the Screenshot Reader or copies text from the Screenshot Reader window
Audio Maker	The number of times a user clicks the Audio Maker feature

Web Search	The number of times a user clicks the Web Search feature
Screen Masking	The number of times a user turns on Screen Masking
Voice Notes	The number of times a user clicks the Voice Notes feature
Practice Reading	The number of times a user clicks the Practice Reading Aloud feature, creates a recording, or shares their recording
Simplify	The number of times a user clicks the Simplify feature, or uses the features within the Simplify page
Rewordify	The number of times a user turns Rewordify on or off, or clicks on rewordified text to see the original text
Miscellaneous	Includes various non-feature events like opening the toolbar, opening the Settings menu, or clicking in-product links such as Texthelp Academy or Support site

Equatio

Feature name	What it means
Academy	User opened the academy window via the hat icon in the drawer
Contextual Action	The buttons that appear above the editor while working in multi-line environments
Dashboard	User sorted or searched in the dashboard
Forms Creator	AI Forms Creator was accessed while in Google Forms
Graph	A graph was inserted into an Equatio platform
Handwriting	Handwritten math from Mobile platform has been inserted
Handwriting Recognition	Handwriting Recognition from toolbar has been used and converted to digital math into right hand editor
Images	An image from Mobile inserted into Mathspace or the location where a Mathspace has been inserted (Docs, Forms, PDF etc.)
Math	User is interacting with Math (ie: Insert Math, Edit Math, Copy Math As, or (Solves Math - *WizKids License Only*)
Math Discoverability	User toggles Discoverability button or math found on page

Mathspace	Insert Mathspace chosen from toolbar or mathspace was inserted into a location running extension
Molecular Viewer	A molecular structure is searched for in the Molecular Viewer
Palette	A palette item is favorited or selected
Prediction	A prediction item is selected from the overlay
Scan Math	Math is inserted from a scan, image, or speech using Mobile
Screenshot Reader	SSR is selected from toolbar and/or selects More Options
Speech Input	Speech Input is chosen as an input method from the extension
Speech Playback	Anytime you hit the play button & voice playback is engaged
STEM Tools	STEM Tools are selected from the toolbar
Tag	A tag for organization is assigned in Mathspace
Toolbar	Frequency of opening and closing the toolbar
Tutorial	Engagement with the Equatio onboarding journey

Feature name	What it means
Text to speech	The number of times a user uses the Speak feature
Screenshot Reader	The number of times a user uses the Screenshot Reader feature
Translate	The number of times a user uses the Translate feature
Outline	The number of times a user engages with the Outline feature, including creating an outline, opening an outline, adding text to an outline, or opening the Sources tab
Dictionary	The number of times a user looks up a word in the double-click Dictionary
Colour Overlay	The number of times a user uses the Color Overlay feature
Remove Distractions	The number of times a user uses the Remove Distractions feature
Word Bank	The number of times a user creates a Word Bank or interacts with a Word Bank
Reports	The number of times a user opens View Reports

Miscellaneous	Includes various non-feature events like toggling on the extension, opening the Options menu, changing settings, or managing educators and students.
Simplify Vocabulary	The number of times a user uses the Rewordify feature

Co:Writer

Feature name	What it means
Text to speech	The number of times a user opens the Read tab, clicks Play or Stop, or changes the reading speed
Prediction	The number of times a user inserts a word from Prediction, switches to inserting numbers
Speech to text	The number of times a user opens the Speech to Text tab, and starts or stops speech to text
Topics	The number of times a user opens the Topics tab, searches for a topic, creates a topic, or turns a topic on/off
Reports	The number of times a user opens View Reports
Translation	The number of times a user inserts a translated word
Miscellaneous	Includes various non-feature events like toggling on the extension, opening the Options menu, changing settings, or managing educators and students.

Feature name	What it means
Text to Speech	The number of times a user uses the Text to Speech feature
Annotations	The number of times a user creates a Text or Pushpin annotation
Highlighters	The number of times a user uses the Highlighters
Integration	The number of times users open, share, or turn in documents via an LMS (Canvas, Brightspace, Schoology, or Google Classroom), or reopen a document via a linked cloud URL
Prediction	The number of times a user turns on Prediction or inserts words from the Prediction list
Freehand Drawing	The number of times a user creates a drawing annotation
Screenshot Reader	The number of times a user uses the Screenshot Reader feature

Picture Dictionary	The number of times a user uses the Picture Dictionary feature
Dictionary	The number of times a user uses the Dictionary feature
Shapes	The number of times a user creates or edits a Shape annotation
Digital signature	The number of times a user opens the Digital Signature tool or inserts a signature
Vocabulary	The number of times a user uses the Vocabulary List feature
Translator	The number of times a user uses the Translator featur
PDF scanning	The number of times a user scans an inaccessible PDF
Split and Merge	The number of times a user engages with the Split and Merge tool or saves a new file
Image to PDF	The number of times a user converts an image to a PDF
Math Tools	The number of times a user engages with the Math Tools such as the Equation Editor, Handwriting Recognition, Speech Input, Screenshot Reader, or inserts math into a PDF.
Download	The number of times a user clicks Download in a PDF
Canvas LTI	The number of times a teacher creates an assignment in Canvas or a student opens an assignment in Canvas
Speech to text	The number of times a user uses the Talk&Type feature

UPar

Feature name	What it means
Time with Benefit Accommodation	The number of users that can comprehend text faster with the use of the text to speech accommodation.
Above Independent Reading Level	The number of users that have an independent reading level below their current grade level but can comprehend text above their independent reading level using the text to speech accommodation.
Exceed Grade Level	The number of users that have an independent reading level below their current grade level, but can comprehend text above their current grade level using text to speech accommodation.

Got to Grade Level	The number of users that have an independent reading level below their current grade level, but can comprehend text at their current grade level using current grade level using the text to speech accommodation.
UDL – Needs to be updated align with current language in the product – “Independent Reader; Accommodation May Enhance Comprehension”	The number of users that have an independent reading level at or above their grade level, but can comprehend text above their current grade level using the text to speech accommodation.
No Benefit	The number of users that gain no comprehension benefit from the speech to text accommodation.
