

# How to Configure Equatio as a Trusted Third Party app in the Google Admin Console

If you click on Equatio and nothing happens, then most likely you need to allow trusted third party access.

First, sign in with your Admin account at [admin.google.com](https://admin.google.com)

Navigate to the left sidebar to Security -> Access and data control -> API Controls

Then click on Manage Third Party-App Access
