

Capture tool in MindView Mac is not working

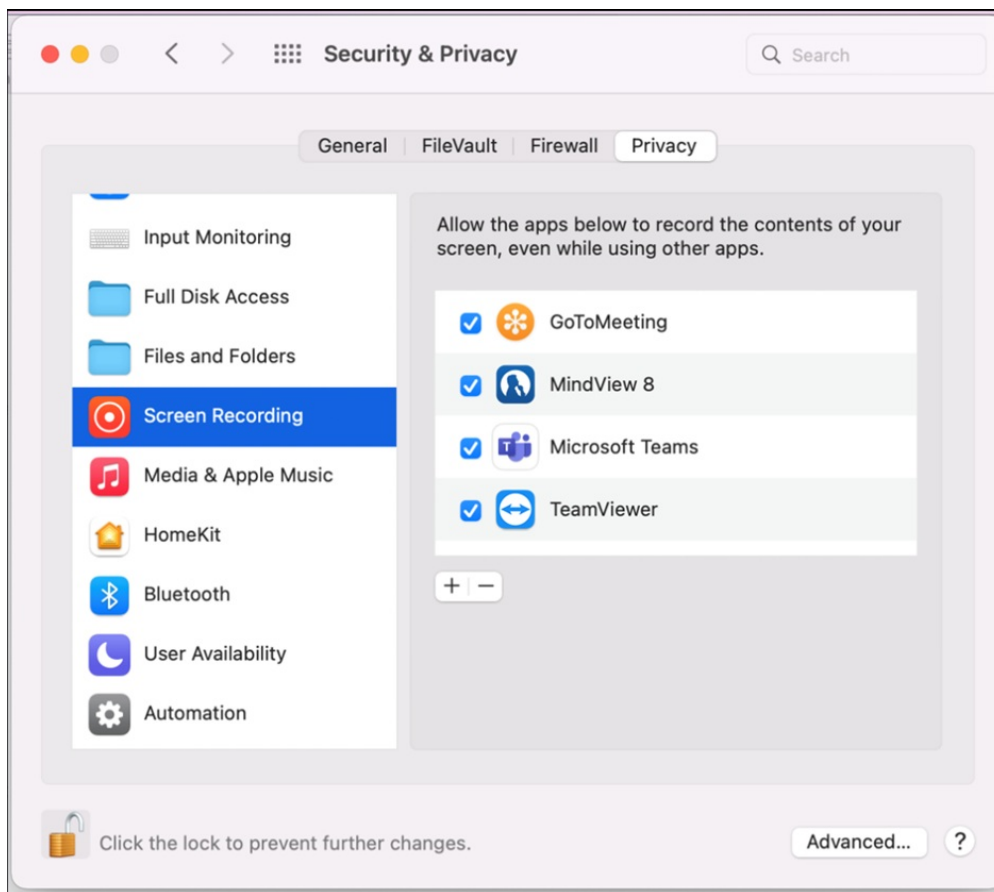
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This usually happens when your Mac needs a quick security adjustment to allow MindView to fully activate.

The fix is fast, and once it's done, you'll **unlock** MindView's full, powerful functionality!

Here is the exact step-by-step fix:

1. Go to the **Apple Menu** (the apple icon in the top-left corner of your screen).
2. Click on **System Settings** (or **System Preferences** if you're on an older macOS version).
3. Select **Privacy & Security**.
4. In the left-hand menu, scroll down and click on **Screen Recording**.
5. Check the list for **MindView**.
 - **If MindView is listed:** Make sure the switch next to it is turned **ON** (it should look green or blue).
 - **If MindView is NOT listed:** Click the + button at the bottom of the window, navigate to your **Applications** folder, and add **MindView**. Then, make sure its switch is turned **ON**.
6. You will likely be prompted to **Quit & Reopen** MindView. Click that option to finalize the change!



That's the key to getting your software up and running without a hitch! This adjustment gives MindView the green light it needs, ensuring a fantastic and smooth user experience.
